

RE: Borrowing Agreement RBC Royal Bank

Recommended Motion:

THAT the Council of the Township of North Glengarry acknowledges and accepts the terms and conditions of the November 5th, 2018 borrowing letter agreement which replaces the April 7, 2010 agreement;

AND THAT the Council of the Township of North Glengarry directs the Director of Finance/Treasurer to submit a borrowing by-law for short term bridge financing to a maximum of \$11,000,000;

AND FURTHERMORE, the Council of the Township of North Glengarry delegates authority to the Mayor and the CAO/Clerk to execute any required documentation to access the short term bridge financing to a maximum of \$11,000,000.

Background / Analysis:

With the Maxville project well underway there is a need for temporary and long-term borrowing for the project. The two have been combined here to assure that total lending requirements could be approved.

The federal portion of the grant for the Maxville Water project is \$15 million and is claim based which means to get the full \$15 million, you must spend \$30 million. The Township must pay for costs up front and submit for reimbursement on a quarterly basis. Reimbursement takes 6 to 8 weeks which causes cash flow shortages that need to be financed on a short-term basis.

For example, expenses paid in April, May and June were be submitted in early July for reimbursement and the monies have yet to be received. This borrowing agreement bridges the gap in timing by providing short term funding. It is predicted that the peak requirement will occur in July of 2019 with a need of close to \$11 million.

At the end of the project, based on what the results of discussion with the Province for additional funding, the Township will need to borrow either \$3.5 million or \$7.5 million. This agreement provides approval of the larger amount if needed and is on a request basis.

Alternatives:

Financial Implications:

Short term financing will require interest payments of roughly \$180,000 which will be considered in the 2019 budget under the water system's operating budget. Reimbursements to the bank for principal will be based on claims received from the federal government.
