Re: Maxville Water - Distribution System Construction Contract

BACKGROUND:

This report is being provided to Council in order to award a contract for the Maxville Water Distribution System Construction.

As an element of the Maxville Water Project, the distribution system was tendered and bids were received on April 10th, 2017.

The Township received 4 bids from contractors and is identified below.

Financial:

See tender results attached. Being that the tenders were only received recently, staff has not had the opportunity to break out the costs below in detail, but it does not change the award. This analysis will be brought forward subsequently.

Estimate:

\$9,000,000 – Water distribution system only.

\$1,000,000 - Added sanitary sewer work, not in original design.

\$ 500,000 - SDG Counties work (economies of scale efficiencies.

\$10,500,000 – Total Estimated Cost

Total Awarded Cost:

Total Bid Price:

\$10,072,268.50

HST:

\$ 1,309,394.91

Subtotal:

\$11,381,663.41

Less HST Rebate:

It's important to understand that there is pricing in the tender that may not be utilized and is provisional only. Therefore the tendered amount does not necessarily indicate the end cost and it could be less. Alternatively, staff is working on a reinstatement plan which may increase the total cost based on available dollars. Furthermore, various change orders and circumstances affecting the estimated unit rates may also increase the cost.

All in all this tender is based on the best information available and actual construction costs will vary.

Recommendation:

THAT, the Council of the Township of North Glengarry passes a resolution authorizing the CAO/Clerk and the Mayor to enter in to an agreement with Clarence McDonald Excavation Ltd. In the amount of \$10,072,268.50 excluding HST;

AND FURTHER, that a contingency of 10% of the construction cost be established for the project in the amount of \$1,007,226.85 and added to the budget for this element;

AND FURTHER, that the Director of Public Works is authorized to issue any and all change orders, alter the scope of the project and spend additional funds as required in order to prevent delays and claims against the Township within the limitations of the contingency;

AND FURTHER, contingency related costs shall be summarized and reported to Council at a regular basisthat any costs over and above the established contingency shall be brought to Council for approval.

Re: Maxville Distribution System - Tender Review

Please find the Tender Verification Checklist, as well as a Bid Analysis of the unit prices submitted by the lowest and 2nd lowest tenderers.

After a review of the Tender results, we have the following comments:

- Clarence McDonald Excavation Ltd. (lowest bidder) submitted a complete package in accordance with the tender requirements.
- Robert Excavation (2nd lowest bidder) did not submit an "Agreement to Bond".

Although there is some variability between the unit prices submitted by the low tenderer and our opinion of probable cost for a number of the items, this is generally not unexpected and is typical of a competitive tendering process. The unit prices submitted by the low tenderer do not appear to be unbalanced.

As there were no prequalification requirements, and the low tenderer submitted a complete and responsive bid that does not appear to be unbalanced, we recommend the Township accept the bid of the low tenderer and enter into a formal Contract with Clarence McDonald Excavation Ltd.

Re: Jacobs (CH2M) Contract Extension

Discussion:

This report is being provided to Council in order to extend Jacobs (formerly CH2M Hill) contract to include the necessary works for the approval of the sanitary sewer works in Maxville under the tender for construction.

With the addition of the sanitary sewer work, staff has incorporated the design components only through CH2M in order to issue the tender. Unconventionally, there is now the requirement to submit all approval documents, calculations, compliance, modelling and residual capacity calculations to support the installation and subsequent "official connection" of the sanitary sewers.

Staff are recommending to extend the contract and proceed with the work through scope change as they are the engineers of record for this project. Seeking alternatives firms for this service is not advisable at this time due to the custodial nature of the work done to date by CH2M/JL Richards.
