Background / Analysis: After a review of the current fees and charges, it was noted that the distribution for water/sewer charges were incorrect. The total charges will remain the same as noted (\$100.83/month or \$1,210.00 per year); however the new rates will be \$66.70/month for water and \$34.13/month for sewer. Fees for tankers will be \$3.38/m3 plus the appropriate filling time.

Recommended Motion:

THAT the Council of the Township of North Glengarry approve the application for a tile drainage loan, roll number 0111-016-00708500-0000 in the amount of \$ 9,800.00; and

THAT the Council of the Township of North Glengarry adopts By-law #02-2020 being a rating by-law to impose special annual drainage rates upon land in respect of which money is borrowed under the *Tile Drainage Act*; and

THAT By-law 02-2020 be read a first, second and third time enacted in open Council on January 13, 2020.

Background / Analysis:

Through the Ontario Ministry of Agriculture, Food and Rural Affairs (OMAFRA), landowners in Ontario municipalities are eligible to receive a loan for tile drainage installation. Applicants are eligible for up to 75% of the total value of the tile drainage work up to \$50,000.00 at an interest rate of 6.00% paid back over a ten-year period.

The owner would like approval for the loan application. Since the Inspection and Completion Certificate have been completed, the Treasury Department is requesting approval of By-law #02-2020 being a rating by-law to impose special rates in respect of money borrowed under the *Tile Drainage Act*.

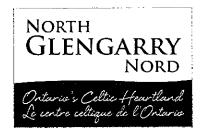

That By-Law #03-2020, being a bylaw to authorize temporary borrowing from time to time during the fiscal year ending December 31, 2020, be read a first, second and third time and adopted in open Council.

Section 407 of the Municipal Act provides authority for a council to authorize temporary borrowing, until such time that taxes are collected and other revenues received, to meet the current expenditures of the Municipality.

The attached is a Bylaw to authorize such temporary borrowing.

Option 2: That Council does not adopt By-law 03-2020.

Financial Implications:

Provides for temporary borrowing, if required, during the fiscal year up to the amount of \$2,000,000.

The THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH GLENGARRY (the "Municipality") By-law No. being a by-law to authorize temporary borrowing from time to time to meet current expenditures during the fiscal year ending December 31, .

WHEREAS Section 407 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, as amended, provides authority for a council by by-law to authorize the head of council or the treasurer or both of them to borrow from time to time, such sums as the council considers necessary to meet, until taxes are collected and other revenues are received, the current expenditures of the Municipality for the year; and

WHEREAS the total amount which may be borrowed from all sources at any one time to meet the current expenditures of the Municipality, except with the approval of the Municipal Board, is limited by Section 407 of the Municipal Act, 2001:

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH GLENGARRY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The head of council or the treasurer or both of them are hereby authorized to borrow from time to time during the fiscal year (hereinafter referred to as the current year) such sums as may be necessary to meet, until taxes are collected and other revenues are received, the current expenditures of the Municipality for the current year.
- 2. The lender(s) from whom amounts may be borrowed under authority of this by-law shall be Royal Bank of Canada and such other lender(s) as may be determined from time to time by by-law of council amounts any outstanding amounts of principal borrowed and accrued interest under Section 407 together with the total of any similar borrowings that have not been repaid, shall not exceed from January ft to September 30th of the current year, 50 percent of the total estimated revenues of the Municipality as set out in the budget adopted for the current year, and from October 1st to December 3ft of the current year, 25 percent of the total of the estimated revenues of the Municipality as set out in the budget adopted for the current year, 25 percent of the total of the estimated revenues of the Municipality as set out in the budget adopted for the current year or \$, whichever is less.
- 4. The treasurer shall, at the time when any amount is borrowed under this by-law, ensure that the lender is or has beenfurnished with a certified copy of this by-law, (a certified copy of the resolution mentioned in section 2 determining the lender,) if applicable, and a statement showing the nature and amount of the estimated revenues for the current year and also showing the total of any other amounts borrowed from any and all sources under authority of section 407 of the *Municipal Act* that have not been repaid.
- 5. a) If the budget for the current year has not been adopted at the time an amount is borrowed under this by-law, the statement furnished under section 4 shall show the nature and amount of the estimated revenues of the Municipality as set forth in the budget adopted for the previous year and the nature and amount of the revenues received for and on account of the current year.
 - b) If the budget for the current year has not been adopted at the time an amount is borrowed under this by-law, the limitation on borrowing set out in section 3 shall be calculated for the time being upon the estimated revenues of the Municipality as set forth in the budget adopted for the previous year less all revenues received for and on account of the current year.
- 6. For purposes of this by-law the estimated revenues referred to in section 3, 4, and 5 do not include revenues derivable or derived from, a) any borrowing, including through any issue of debentures; b) a surplus, including arrears of taxes, fees or charges; or c) a transfer from the capital fund, reserve funds or reserves.
- 7. The treasurer be and is hereby authorized and directed to apply in payment of all or, any sums borrowed under this by- law, together with interest thereon, all or any of the moneys hereafter collected or received, either on account of or realized in respect of the taxes levied for the current year and previous years or from any other source, that may be lawfully applied for such purpose.
- 8. Evidences of indebtedness in respect of borrowings made under section 1 shall be signed by the head of the council or conform to the treasurer or both of them.
- 9. The Bank shall not be responsible for establishing the necessity of temporary borrowing under this by-law or the manner in which the borrowing is used.
- 10. This by-law shall take effect on the final day of passing.

BEING A BY-LAW TO ADOPT, CONFIRM AND RATIFY MATTERS DEALT WITH BY RESOLUTION.

WHEREAS s. 5(3) of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, provides that the powers of municipal corporation are to be exercised by its Council by by-law; and

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient that the proceedings, decisions and votes of the Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Glengarry at this meeting be confirmed and adopted by by-law;

THEREFORE, the Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Glengarry enacts as follows:

- 1. **THAT** the action of the Council at its regular meeting of January 13, 2020 in respect to each motion passed and taken by the Council at its meetings, is hereby adopted, ratified and confirmed, as if each resolution or other action was adopted, ratified and confirmed by its separate by-law; and;
- 2. THAT the Mayor and the proper officers of the Township of North Glengarry are hereby authorized and directed to do all things necessary to give effect to the said action, or to obtain approvals where required, and except where otherwise provided, The Mayor and the Clerk are hereby directed to execute all documents necessary in that behalf and to affix the corporate seal of the Township to all such documents.
- 3. THAT if due to the inclusion of a particular resolution or resolutions this By-law would be deemed invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction then Section 1 to this By-law shall be deemed to apply to all motions passed except those that would make this By-law invalid.
- 4. **THAT** where a "Confirming By-law" conflicts with other by-laws the other by-laws shall take precedence. Where a "Confirming By-Law" conflicts with another "Confirming By-law" the most recent by-law shall take precedence.
