This is for bulk filling such as large containers, commercial businesses etc. The fill site is connected to our main water line. Companies can set up an account with a PIN for recurring use, and residents can also pay per fill if they require bulk water.

Easy and efficient to use, just select how much water you need. You will only be charged for how much water you take.
