RE: Sound System and Microphones

Recommended Motion:

THAT Council for the Township of North Glengarry receives Staff Report No. AD-2018-04, and

THAT Council approves purchase of a Sound System and Microphones to an upset limit of \$20,000 to be funded \$10,000 from Unfinanced Capital carried forward from the 2017 budget and \$10,000 from the General Capital Fund.

Background / Analysis:

The 2017 Capital Budget had \$10,000 budgeted for the replacement of the sound system and microphones. This amount was carried forward into 2018 in the Unfinanced Capital Account. Staff have researched the cost of upgrading the sound system and purchasing new microphones and have estimated the cost to be approximately \$20,000. Due to ongoing issues with the current system, Staff are requesting that Council approve the request for additional funds to allow for the necessary work to start as soon as possible.

Alternatives:

Option 1: THAT Council approves the purchase of the sound system and microphones to be funded from the Unfinanced Capital and General Capital Fund

Option 2: Not recommended – THAT Council declines the purchase of the sound system and microphones.

Financial Implications:

There are sufficient funds in the General Capital Fund for this initiative.

RE: Maxville Community Hall Floor Replacement

Recommended Motion:

THAT the Council for the Township of North Glengarry receives the Staff Report No. CS-2018-20; and

THAT Council approves the transfer of use in an upset amount of \$10,825.23 plus HST from the Maxville & District Sports Complex' Capital Budget towards the purchase and installation of a liquid membrane prior to the installation of the vinyl composite tiles in the Community Hall; and

THAT the Chief Administrative Officer and the Director of Community Services are hereby authorized to execute the documentation relevant to this project.

Background / Analysis:

Council awarded the tender CS-2018-03 for the replacement of the flooring in the Community Hall in the Maxville & District Sports Complex as per the Staff Report CS-2018-18 presented on May 14, 2018. Testing, as required under this tender, revealed over recommended limits of moisture in the flooring. Staff has repaired masonry around the facility which in the past was largely responsible for the deterioration and lifting of the existing vinyl composite tiles but installation of new tiles with these high levels of moisture would nullify the manufacturer's warranty as well as the guarantee for the installer's labour.

In order to properly install the new vinyl composite tiles, the existing concrete floor must be prepped and a liquid membrane applied. The total cost for this work, including the product and labour, is \$10,825.23 plus HST as quoted by Les Couvre-planchers Clément.

Staff proposes using remaining funds from another Capital Project initially estimated at \$17,000 – the Replacement of Parking Lot Lighting which came in under \$5,000 since only the LED heads required replacement leaving \$12,000 in this account. Staff suggests a transfer of use for these funds towards the flooring project to ensure a proper and durable installation.

Alternatives:

Option 1 – Recommended – That Council approves the transfer of use of Capital Funds towards this purchase.

Or

Option 2 – Not recommended – That Council declines this additional component to the flooring project for the Community Hall at the Maxville & District Sports Complex.

Financial Implications:

The remaining \$12,000 from the Replacement of Parking Lot Lighting project more than offsets the requested transfer of funding in the amount of \$10,825.23 plus HST that would be applied towards the preparation of the floor and the purchase and install of the liquid membrane prior to the installation of the vinyl composite tiles.

The funds remain within the same Capital Budget envelope and do not increase nor decrease the whole of the Capital funding for the Maxville & District Sports Complex as allocated by Council.
