



## Meeting Highlights

### Community Outdoor Rink

Council approved the Glengarry Sports Palace parking lot as the location of the new Community Outdoor Rink. At the May 24, 2022 meeting, a delegation came to Council on a proposed Community Outdoor Rink Project in honour of Alain Larocque. Council was in support of the project at the time and instructed staff to begin conversations with the group. Over the past several months, staff continued to discuss the project with the group about location, timing and funding. As a result, the organization recently approached Staff with the idea of building on Township property. A location in the Glengarry Sports Palace parking lot was suggested by the group. Staff evaluated the area and put forth the recommendation to Council, which was unanimously approved.

### Update to 2023 Community Grants

Council approved the Community Grant to the Alexandria Curling Club in the amount of \$1,850.00 payable through the Community Grant Program funding in the 2023 municipal budget. Under the theme of "100 years of Curling and Community Engagement," the group is planning many events. The main event will be indoor curling at the Alexandria Curling Club in October 2023, which will be followed by a catered dinner and music. Everyone is welcome to attend this event, which invites people to learn about the history of curling.

### Roads Needs Study Workplan for 2023

Council approved the Roads Capital Workplan for 2023, which includes many sections of the Township road network to be upgraded. Studies completed in 2022 for 2023 showed that a road that was to be reconstructed for 1.5 million would need an additional 1.2 million to reinforce the base of the road. Public Works has investigated alternative paths suggested in the 2021 Roads Need Study due to the cost. More investigation into alternatives for the road will be carried out in collaboration with the County due to the size and traffic loading. As a result of these additional investigations, alternative road works were put forth as recommended capital projects for 2023 and approved by Council.
