Recreation Union on Strike

SEIU Local 2 of the Brewery General and Professional Workers' Union (SEIU), opted to exercise its legal right to strike.

This strike comes after mediated negotiations, which began in late 2023, reached a standstill between the Township of North Glengarry and union representatives. Negotiations remained ongoing during the strike, and a successful agreement was reached, pending ratification and acceptance by both sides.

North Glengarry represented at AMO

Council and staff attended the Association of Municipalities of Ontario conference in Ottawa.

Council lobbied on behalf of the Township for the Ministry of Education's support in our upcoming application to the Ministry of Infrastructure for our lagoon project. Expanded capacity means more housing, which brings in more children to fill our schools, which currently there are over 800 vacant spaces. It means reducing ecological risk and complying with environmental regulations. It translates into new industrial clients and expanded commercial opportunities, which turns into more residential growth. One investment from the Province has a huge influence and a lasting impact not only within the Township of North Glengarry, but the surrounding Counties, while fulfilling many of the various Ministry's objectives.

Heritage property designation in progress

Earlier in 2024, Council was informed that Bill 23 introduced changes to the *Ontario Heritage Act R.S.O 1990, c. O. 18, s 27* (the "Act") meant to prevent non-designated properties from languishing indefinitely on heritage registers. The amendments gave municipalities two years to either designate or remove properties from their heritage registers. Council approved staff to proceed with the designation process to the Municipal Register for six properties as recommended by the Arts, Culture and Heritage Committee. A Notice of Intent will be delivered to the property owners, and an ad published in local newspapers and on the Township's website. Property owners have 30 days to object to having their property included on the registry.

Please note: Council meetings are held in person at the Township of North Glengarry's Municipal Office located at 3720 County Road 34 in Alexandria, all are welcome.
