Heritage Building Designations

6 properties will move forward with heritage designations. Each has been identified as being of cultural heritage value and interest within the Township of North Glengarry in the United Counties of Stormont, Dundas and Glengarry

- St-Elmo Presbyterian Church – 1992 County Rd 20, Maxville
- Private Property – St-Elmo Congregational Church – 18191 Kenyon Conc 19, Maxville
- Private Residence – 6 Church St, Maxville
- Private Residence – 101 Centre St, Alexandria
- Private Residence – 53 Dominion St, Alexandria
- Commercial Property – 209-215 Main St N, Alexandria

In accordance with Section 29(3) of the Ontario Heritage Act, Notice of Intent letters were issued to the property owners on September 11, 2024. An ad containing the Notice of Intent to Designate all six properties was published in The Review newspaper on September 11, 2024.

No objections were received, and Council voted in favour of these properties being designated.

Recreation Master Plan Approved

Council approved the Parks and Recreation Master Plan and Action Plan. Council also voted in favour of directing staff to apply to the Community Sport and Recreation Infrastructure Fund (CSRIF) for the replacement of the Maxville & District Sports Complex arena slab and related components.

Remembering former Mayor, Chris McDonell

The Township of North Glengarry Council and staff wish to share their deepest sympathies with the McDonell family with the passing of former North Glengarry Mayor, Chris McDonell. Chris McDonell had a celebrated 18-year career in politics.

A former detective with the Ontario Provincial Police (OPP), Chris served as a Councillor at Large, Deputy Mayor and later Mayor for North Glengarry. Mayor McDonell entered his first election race in November 2000, when he was elected at "councillor at large". He was re-elected to this position in 2003.

In 2006, he ran for Deputy Mayor, winning a closely contested election against two other opponents. He maintained this position during the 2010 election, which he won by acclamation. Running for Mayor in the January 2012 by-election, McDonell was elected and again re-elected by acclamation during the 2014 municipal election.

McDonell also served as Warden of the Counties of Stormont-Dundas-Glengarry in 2009. Chris was a huge supporter of his community. He was always attending events, even post retirement, in a truly caring Glengarian way. As Mayor and Councillor, he continuously worked on ensuring the residents were served well. "I am not sure if there is anyone who has held North Glengarry closer to their heart." Says Mayor Jamie MacDonald. "He always operated in the best interest of our Township, and we are grateful for the legacy he put in place for North Glengarry."



Muir's Bakery gets an upgrade
