New 9-1-1 dispatch system for North

Glengarry The United Counties of Stormont, Dundas and Glengarry have adopted the Medical Priority Dispatch System as of April 10, 2024. This internationally recognized system operates under five, colourcoded categories based on the severity of the medical emergency. Life-threatening/priority calls will be assigned the closest ambulance, irrespective of jurisdiction or prior assigned medical calls, to ensure those patients most in need will get immediate assistance. Non-urgent cases will receive regular monitoring from dispatchers until an ambulance arrives, should prioritization need to change.

Bulk water fill station

Council has awarded a tender for a bulk water filling station in Alexandria

Dispatchers will be asking more detailed questions to callers to best assess their medical situation to allow for a triaged approach to allocating resources. Critical cases will be prioritized to ensure the most efficient response for emergent medical care. This system will also encourage residents to utilize non-emergent resources including <u>Health811</u>, pharmacists or family physicians and walk-in clinics.

Tenders awarded for public works projects

Council has awarded tenders for multiple public works initiatives in North Glengarry. Work on the Bishop Street bridge and the replacement of the Dominion Street bridge, both in Alexandria will begin in the near future. A tender for the sanitary sewer CCTV work was also awarded. The Township inspects its entire sanitary sewer system over a two-year period every four years. This allows staff to find and repair cracks and deficiencies to reduce water infiltration.

Bulk Water Fill Station Coming


The bulk water fill station is a dispenser that will be installed on

the fire hydrant across from the Alexandria Water Tower on Industrial Boulevard. The bulk water fill station will digitally record and dispense water to bulk fill trucks that currently purchase water for different uses such as filling backyard pools.

Large users (companies) will have an account with a pin number and one-off users can utilize a credit card to pay at the station. The final billing rate has yet to be determined and will appear yearly in the township's fees and charges by-law.

Community Garden Coming to Alexandria

On April 29, Council approved the allocation of funds to move forward with a Community Garden project at at 199 Main Street North in Alexandria, former location of the water tower. Below is a draft plan for the garden.
